Greetings in the Name of the Prince of Peace:

It seems I have written so many letters to you all this time of year and all of them asking something OF you. Today I am writing to wish something FOR you. In Isaiah 9:6, the prophet speaks names for the Messiah:

For a child has been born for us,
a son given to us;
authority rests upon his shoulders,
and he is named
Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God,
Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. (NRSVUE)

In these four names for the Messiah Isaiah gives, we get a picture of God's provision. When the Messiah comes, Isaiah is saying, he is coming to bring all the things we will ever need to find fullness as God's children. In fact, one might say that Jesus comes to remind us of all the things God already is and perhaps the things we have forgotten. Jesus, fully God and fully human, is born to show us who God is and to remind us of who we are as God's children. Each name in Isaiah's list offers to meet our many different needs. A colleague of mine wrote about their understanding of God, "God is infinite and intimate, at the same time." God can be exactly who God needs to be for each of us and for all of us at the same time.

Jesus is Wonderful Counselor. He is our guide in decision making. When we are wrestling with the difficulties and challenges life presents, Jesus is both a great listener and a perfect example for the way forward. I often, but probably not often enough, speak

prayers aloud as a way of processing and untangling thoughts.

Jesus is Mighty God. The word mighty suggests power and strength and refers to sheer size or immensity. There is no greater God than the One True God. No God more powerful. But the way Jesus demonstrates power in the world is not with brute strength but with meekness and humility that allow him access to the power of God. When we rely on our own power, it is limited. When we submit to the will of God, we have access to the mighty, unlimited power of God.

Jesus is Everlasting Father. God loves us, his children, unconditionally, and without end. When I think of my own children, I know there is nothing they could ever do to make me love them less or anything they need to do to make me love them more. This is exactly how God loves each of us.

Jesus is the Prince of Peace. In John 14:27, Jesus says, "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled, and do not let them be afraid." The peace Jesus offers is inexhaustible, and it requires nothing of us but to receive what is given. There is no greater need in our families, in our communities, in our country, or indeed in our world than God's peace. The good news is that in Jesus, it is available in every way necessary.

This Advent, may we make room for the gift of Jesus in our lives and in our world, once more. And may any trouble in our hearts or fear in our souls be replaced by the very Peace of Christ!




"Comfort, comfort my people, says God"
