

Make Your Own Reed Diffusers





How cool to have a reminder of Mary anointing Jesus' feet as a scent filling your house! Bake your own reed diffusers to spread a beautiful perfume through your house.

All you need is some **bamboo skewers** (or actual reeds, of course), some **small-mouthed jars** (the pictures above were from a spice rack at the thrift store for \$2), and some **liquid potpourri** (or make your own scent from essential oils, etc.). You can find liquid potpourri at the dollar store and at Wal-Mart for \$3. It's not Scentsy, but it gets the job done!

Cut the bamboo skewers to be a more manageable size and **decorate the jars**. Grab some **scrapbook paper**, **ribbon**, and **cross stickers**. Wrap, tie and decorate all different designs until the jars looked beautiful enough to give as a gift!

When the perfume bottles are finished (filled with about an inch or two of the liquid potpourri & about 4 bamboo skewers), place one in every room of our house or give them away.
